**Please note:** *Camp ISD* welcomes siblings of children who are deaf or hard of hearing, age five years and older. However, *Camp ISD* cannot provide childcare. Parents are responsible for their children at all times when children are not in a workshop. Children who are deaf or hard of hearing entering 3<sup>rd</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall are eligible to attend a summer camp at ISD, during the time parents are at Camp ISD.
