The training focuses on screening for infants, toddlers and young children. We will discuss when and how to refer for further assessment and/or services.

In vision, participants will learn how and who to screen as well as who is at risk of vision impairments, warning signs, as well as types of screening tools.

In hearing, participants will learn the types and causes of hearing loss, its impact on development, communication and language, as well as the use of a screening questionnaire.
